It's easy to forget what Memorial Day actually means while you're sitting by the pool and looking ahead at summer vacation—but the historical reason for the holiday signifies much more than just a three-day weekend.

Memorial Day is a solemn day of remembrance for everyone who has died serving in the American armed

forces. The holiday, originally known as Decoration Day, started after the Civil War to honor the Union and Confederate dead.

It's unclear exactly where the holiday originated—Charleston, S.C., Waterloo, N.Y., Columbus, Ga. and other towns all claim to be the birthplace of Memorial Day. The event in Charleston that may have precipitated

Memorial Day offers poignant evidence of a country struggling to rebuild itself after a bloody war: 257 Union soldiers died in prison in Charleston during the Civil War and were buried in unmarked graves, and the town's black residents organized a May Day ceremony in which they landscaped a burial ground to properly honor the soldiers.

In the years following the Civil War, Memorial Day celebrations were scattered and, perhaps unsurprisingly, took root differently in the North and South. It wasn't until after World War II that the holiday gained a strong following and national identity, and it wasn't officially named Memorial Day until 1967.

The final event that cemented the modern culture of Memorial Day in America was in 1968 when Congress passed the Uniform Holiday Act, designating Memorial Day as the last Monday in May rather than May 30, as it had previously been observed. (This year, Memorial Day falls on Monday, May 25.) This ensured a three-day weekend and gave the day its current status as the unofficial beginning of summer, mixing serious reflection with more lighthearted fun.

The third and last of the volumes three, is locked from sight - God keepeth the key.




WILLIAN F. NELSON - MARCH 4, 2024


CHARLES MICK - MARCH 26, 2024

Hospital Notes from March 26, 2024

The last Board of Governors meeting for Shriners Children's Chicago was held on 26th March, 2024, in person in Chicago with both Kaaba representatives present.

Over the past years, you have been informed about the number of patients seen each month and some comparison to the previous total for the year to date. When looking at a total year number for all the Shriners Children's locations, these facts can really be appreciated for the large number of patients seen at the Chicago location.

The Pediatric Specialties in Chicago are: treatment for orthopedic conditions, burn care, spinal cord injury, cleft lip and palate issues, along with rehabilitation and management <u>care</u>. These are the most care requested but not the only options provided at Chicago.

Shriners Children's have served patients from all 50 US States and 108 countries around the world including the US territories. There have been 223,902 life changing surgeries, 214,594 clinic procedures, 51,852 prosthetic and orthopedic deliveries as well as 57,999 new patients, 347,839 rehabilitation procedures, 38,699 inpatient days, 14,238 Telehealth encounters, 38 million miles traveled by road and/or air, all accomplished because of the generosity of 1.4 million Philanthropy Donors. Does this number include YOU?

Chicago statistics for February are: total surgeries were 85 with 47 outpatients and 38 inpatients surgeries of which 15 of those being spine surgeries. There were 1408 on site visits and 1408 rehabilitation visits with 196 new patients.

Intake procedures are being changed to improve both the patients' time and the transporting time. To be more convenient, handling of appointment time is being developed to help both new and established patients. What will happen when a patient requests an appointment to the hospital, the person confirming the appointment knows the normal travel time from the Shrine Center location to the Hospital and will set an appointment time where the patient and driver will be able to make the appointment without departing the Shrine Center in the early hours of the day. For all voice and email requests for services, the response time frame goal is within 24-hours.

Chicago Leadership Conference will take place on June 20-21, 2024 with more information to come as flyers will be sent to each Shrine Center that is served by the Hospital. A new Physical Referral Liaison had been hired for the Quad Cities and surrounding areas. This person is Ms. Jessica Myers, from Silvis, II. She started on 18 March 2024.

The Chicago hospital has lost several persons due to either finding better employment that will fit their schedule and or are leaving for better education. We are in need of a radiologist, a job skill that is in demand in most hospitals today. There is also a need for nursing skilled personnel. Our turnover rate for February was only .3%.

Equipment needed now is sterilizers for the operating rooms. Two have been requested and at the present time we have only one working, so we must send surgery equipment to a company that can sterilize and return the surgery packs when needed, making this a costly process. The CT/ MRI request is in the final stages and the modular type building to hold this required equipment will be erected on site.

Our plant and facilities are doing a good job in maintaining the building and grounds. Security Emergency Capital for additional fencing is about 90% completed, external lighting has been added with the coverage around the outside of the building becoming more adequate. There have been two bids on roof replacement and still waiting on a third bid before a contract can proceed. Some of the security doors need upgrading or to be totally replaced.

The 2024 "Watch Me" campaign will have television, OTT streaming TV, radio and digital application throughout the year. Additional marketing should begin soon and we will see more Shriners Hospital advertising in the Quad Cities marketing media.




